Supplies needed may vary depending on the time of year, age and number of girls, and planned activities. Use this list as a guideline only, and check with the Booking Agent and/or your Camp Adviser if you have any questions. No personal gear is provided; see the kit list for recommendations.

- At least 2 Britta filters (Britta jug provided) to clarify / dechlorinate sterilized drinking water

- Groceries (incl. oil for cooking, salt and pepper)
- Facial tissues
- Toilet paper (white, single-ply only)

- Means of disposing of sanitary supplies (Cannot be put down the outhouse)
- Program/craft supplies
- Duct tape (optional)

- 1st Aid Kit for use in an event of an evacuation injury (Burn, fracture, deep cut) (key provided to contact guider)
